
Welcome aboard Infinium

Day 1. Phi Phi Island via Koh Kai Nai



- Departure point will be dependent on guest arrival time. Customs check out formalities are over quite quickly.
- · Guests are shown to their cabins and given lifejacket, safety and systems briefing.
- Cast off mid morning for the famous Phi Phi island stopping off at the stunning Koh Kai Nai for lunch and a swim.
- Arriving just before Sunset at Maya Bay will see very few tourists to spoil the tranquility and
 majesty of this amazing island abundant in Caves and bays. Anchoring can be within reach of
 the night life or choose the peaceful option off a palm lined beach on the Eastern side

Day 2. Phi Phi to Koh Lanta



- An Early start and we are off to the Magical Koh Lanta to spend the night.
- There will be time to explore the much visited Old Town settlement, one of the oldest in the Area.
- The Village of Stilt buildings jutting out into the sea seems a little lost in time...

Day 3. Koh Lanta-Koh Muk-Koh Rok Nok







- To wake after a night aboard off Old Town is wonderful.
- Breakfast will be served under way as we head for the Jewel of Thailand, Koh Muk, home to the Emerald Cave.
- Said to be one of the most amazing natural attractions found here those able will snorkel (those unable can Kayak) through a 100 metre cave to find a sandy beach inside a cavern with vaulted walls rising hundreds of meters skywards coated in lush vegetation.
- After a brief stop we will set sail for the geographically isolated Ko Rok Nok National Park to anchor for the night.

Day 4. Koh Rok Nok To Butang Islands




- Again Breakfast will be served underway as we head for the Butang Island group.
 Also predominantly National Park these untouched unspoilt islands are

- Visit the quaint island of Ko Lipe which serves as the accommodation base for the group. It is an extremely laid back island...

Day 5. Explore the Butang Islands








- Explore The beaches and the reefs around the Butang group. With Fantastic visibility most of the year.

Day 6. Butang group to Langkawi




- After breakfast at anchor we set sail for the 99 islands of Langkawi steeped in Legend.
